Safety Precautions and Our Parks

Our parks, playgrounds and the dog park reopened to the public on March 20, 2021 to provide outdoor recreation and leisure activities during the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic.

The City of South Euclid asks that all park goers please take extra precautions to stay healthy and safe for your protection – as well as those of other park visitors. The park facilities remain "use at your own risk" during the pandemic, so please wear face coverings and maintain at least 6 feet of distance between yourself and others when outside and avoid congregating in groups.

Hand Sanitizing Stations have been installed throughout Bexley and Quarry Park, so please sanitize hands frequently, including before and after using play equipment. Also, please stay home if you or your child feels sick.

Please note that park restrooms are undergoing renovations and will remain closed for the next several weeks. All restrooms are being converted to touchless faucets and toilets to better protect residents, and we look forward to opening them as soon as renovations are completed. In the meantime, taking personal responsibility for yourself and your family can go a long way toward helping you stay healthy:

<u>Wear a Face Covering:</u> In accordance with the Governor's statewide orders, please wear face coverings.

Think First: Stay home if you are sick or have symptoms.

Bring Hand Sanitizer: Wash your hands before coming to the park, carry hand sanitizer and use it after touching benches, play areas etc.

Keep Your Distance: Maintain 6 feet between yourself and others

Come Prepared: Bring your own drinking water, carry out your trash and be prepared for the temporary restroom closures.
